You've always wanted to see Alaska in real depth, and this 12-night cruse/tour is the best way for you to not just see Alaska, but to experience the ultimate adventure that Alaska has to offer!!

Itinerary

<u> May 20, 2026 - Your Alaskan Journey Begins!</u>

Today you'll board your flight bound for **Anchorage**, where you'll check in to your hotel this evening with dinner on your own. Overnight: Anchorage - Springhill Suites Midtown Hotel

May 21, 2026 - Come Sail Away with Azamara!

You'll awake this morning in **Anchorage**, Alaska's largest city that's surrounded by six mountain ranges! After your hotel breakfast, you'll then transfer south to the pier in **Whittier** and be assisted with boarding the **Azamara Pursuit** in time to enjoy a late lunch. You'll sail away tonight at **6pm**! (B/L/D)

<u>May 22, 2026 - Valdez, Alaska</u>

You'll dock today at **Valdez** from **7:30am** to **3pm**, a lesser-known yet magnificent town surrounded by dramatic landscapes and diverse wildlife. Nestled along **Prince William Sound**, this picturesque village offers towering mountains, wildflower-carpeted meadows, iceberg-dotted waters, expansive glaciers, and nearby **Keystone Canyon**'s spectacular waterfalls! Outdoors activities include fishing, whale watching, and glacier hikes - or simply explore the local shops and fresh seafood. (B/L/D)

May 23, 2026 - Cruise Hubbard Glacier!

Today, the Pursuit cruises **Hubbard Glacier**. At an amazing 75 miles long, it's the **longest river of ice in North America**! This frostyblue wonder, named for National Geographic Society's first president, is one of the **most active glaciers of its kind in Alaska**, measuring 1,350 square miles of translucent blue ice. Amazingly, its 300-foot wall of ice has actually been thickening and **advancing toward the Gulf of Alaska** in sharp contrast to most glaciers which have thinned and are retreating. And you'll be able to witness this awe-inspiring phenomenon from onboard your luxurious ship, while also keeping an eye out for whales, harbor seals and otters. (B/L/D)

May 24, 2026 - Haines, Alaska

You'll arrive in Haines at 8am, a town with a fascinating history, intriguing culture and breathtaking scenery. Located along the edge of North America's longest and deepest fjord, the rugged mountain vistas and seascapes are a photographer's delight! Visit museums dedicated to the area's earliest residents, the Native Tlingit people, and also to a national favorite, the American Bald Eagle. Be sure to visit Fort William H. Seward Base, the first permanent post in Alaska, and enticing local watering holes like the Port Chilkoot Distillery and Haines Brewing Company! Your ship sails this evening at **8pm**. (B/L/D)

May 25, 2026 - Icy Strait Point, Alaska

Icy Strait Point is built on the site of a salmon cannery with restored buildings now housing a variety of restaurants, a museum and local arts and crafts shops. The port is a cultural hub for the original inhabitants of the area, the Hoonah people. Fly down North America's longest and highest zip line or journey into the wilds of Chichagof Island as you explore the Spasski River valley, famous for having one of the world's highest densities of coastal brown bears! The historic Cannery complex houses several shops, all 100% Alaskan-owned with authentic Alaska-made gifts. You're here from 8am to 6pm. (B/L/D)

<u> May 26, 2026 - Sitka, Alaska</u>

You'll dock in **Sitka** from **7am** to **3pm**. The only Inside Passage town fronting the Pacific Ocean, it sits in the shadow of **Mount Edgecumbe**, a dormant volcano with a graceful cone reminiscent of Japan's Mount Fuji. Located on Sitka Sound, the city is dotted with picturesque remnants of its original **Russian heritage**, including the onion-shaped domes and gold crosses of the beloved **St. Michael's Russian Orthodox Cathedral**. When Russia sold Alaska to the US in 1867, the transfer ceremony took place on **Sitka's Castle Hill**. Visit the **Fortress of the Bear** and Alaska **Raptor Center** for an up-close look at orphaned brown bear cubs, injured bald eagles and other birds. (B/L/D)

May 27, 2026 - Ketchikan, Alaska

After sailing north through the night, you'll dock in **Ketchikan** at **8am**. It's often called both the **"Salmon Capital of the World"** and the **"First City,"** as it's typically the first stop for many visitors to Alaska. Here, you might choose to experience a **float plane flight to the Misty Fjords**, lifting off to another world as you see waterfalls that plunge 1,000 feet, beautiful river valleys and crystalline lakes surrounded by pristine forests, an experience you won't soon forget. This favorite port of call features colorful **Creek Street**, lined with charming shops, great seafood dining options and historic buildings, as well as the **Totem Heritage Center** to explore the area's Indigenous culture and art. Your ship sails at **9pm**. (B/L/D)

May 28, 2026 - Klawock, Alaska

Klawock, where you'll dock at 9:30am, is a relatively hidden gem on Prince of Wales Island, known for its rich Tlingit native heritage and also the largest collection of authentic totem poles in Alaska! You can walk the beautiful Klawock River trail and visit a carving shed, then explore fascinating Klawock Totem Park which reveals the cultural significance of these intricately carved poles. You might also choose to go whale watching here, or to visit the Klawock River Hatchery to find out all about salmon conservation. Your ship sails at 5pm. (B/L/D)
